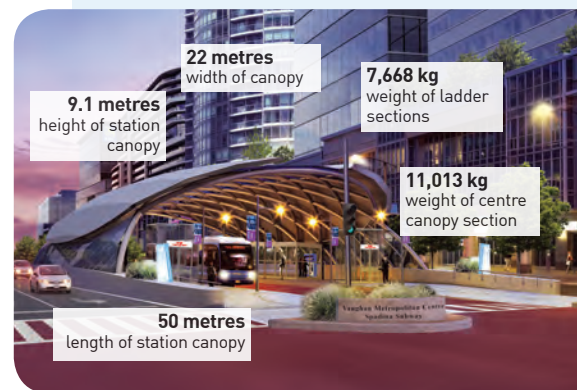
Vaughan is attracting residential and business development to the Vaughan Metropolitan Centre [VMC] area, and this urban space will evolve over time to combine great transit access with new residential, business, entertainment and cultural centres.

Vaughan Metropolitan Centre Station—Viva bus rapid transit

- » Vaughan Metropolitan Centre [VMC] Station is located in the middle of Highway 7 West at Millway Avenue. The opening of this vivastation and the bus rapidway from Edgeley Boulevard to Jane Street will coincide with the opening of the TTC Line 1 Subway Extension, December 17, 2017.
- » This unique vivastation is part of a key transit hub where passengers will be able to connect with other Viva bus routes, the TTC subway, York Region Transit [YRT] at SmartCentres Place Bus Terminal, or shop and enjoy the VMC area.

- » The vivaNext rapid transit project will result in benefits for the entire community, with pedestrian-friendly boulevards, bike lanes, tree planting and more.
- » The 3.6-kilometre segment of the vivaNext rapidway project from Edgeley Blvd. to Bowes Rd. consists of Vaughan Metropolitan Centre Station, as well as Creditstone Road Station and Keele Street Station. The Creditstone and Keele Stations and the rapidway between Jane St. to Bowes Rd. were completed in December, 2016, and the dedicated bus lanes were put into service in February, 2017.

Fun facts about VMC Station [Viva]:



TTC Line 1 [1] Subway Extension extends to Vaughan Metropolitan Centre Station

- » This new subway station and the Line 1 Subway Extension are scheduled to open December 17, 2017.
- » This 8.6-kilometre subway extension includes six new stations, travelling from Sheppard West [formerly Downsview] Station, northwest through York University, to Vaughan Metropolitan Centre at Highway 407.

SmartCentres Place Bus Terminal



- » This nine-bay terminal for YRT buses is situated in VMC with easy connections to the TTC Line 1 Subway Extension and Viva bus rapid transit.
- » It is scheduled to be open for service 2018.
- » The VMC subway station and Viva rapid transit station at Highway 7 are only a two-minute walk through an aboveground park or an underground path, making this terminal the best way to connect.

- » SmartCentres Place Bus Terminal will provide a comfortable location for transit customers to arrive, transfer and depart from, within a short walk of the amenities.
- » The terminal features modern, open architecture and will be accessible from every direction to pedestrians, cyclists and transit customers.

rapidway construction underway—Highway 7 W and Bathurst & Centre

- » Emerging from both sides of the VMC area is the next phase of the rapidway project, extending west along Highway 7 to Bruce Street, and east from Bowes Road to Yonge Street via the existing Viva route along Bathurst and Centre Streets.
- » The new sections of rapidway, consisting of 10 new vivastations—will connect customers from Woodbridge, Concord and Thornhill



to the VMC and the new subway extension. It will also connect people to the rest of York Region via the Richmond Hill Centre Terminal at Yonge Street, and the future Yonge Subway Extension.
